

I am directed to state that the Commission has received a representation from The National Rifle Association of India regarding exemption from depositing of Arms and Ammunition. In this connection I am directed to invite to your attention to the Commission's standing instructions vide letter No. 437/GE-99/PLN-III/ MCC dated 28.07.1999 which allows the members of the National Rifle Association at different levels to be exempted from the restrictions imposed under the Commission's order No. 464/99/PLN-I dated 13.03.1996 and other subsequent orders regarding deposit of arms/ammunitions and to reiterate that such standing instructions of the Commission are applicable in every General Election to Lok Sabha / State legislative Assembly.
